

- Global Distribution Model Process and System. Assist Church leaders and members come unto Christ by effectively and efficiently producing, managing and distributing sacred resources."
  - ☐ Simplify Church global distribution by gathering and transforming fragmented resources and processes into an integrated, efficient, flexible and responsive design.
  - ☐ Global Business Process Focus
    - Sourcing (Acquisition or Production)
    - Inventory Processing (Warehouse/Storehouse Inventory Management and Control)
    - Order Fulfilling (Multi-channel: Web, Retail, Direct, Units)
    - Transporting (Internal and External)
- Global Solution / Core Systems Strategy. Define and follow Global ERP and Core Systems Strategy that provides criteria for developing core systems and criteria for purchasing vendor provided applications vs. custom development.
  - Develop Specific Criterion for Buy vs. Build decisions
  - Develop strategy and approach in choosing between combination of ERP and Best of Breed applications
- Accelerate availability of essential information and training materials to Customers/Employees/Individuals. Provide web-based self-service information and training services to assist Church leaders, members, non-members and employees:
  - Improve ability to find and process information, access training programs, applications, and help about the services Materials Management and Welfare Services provides.
  - Create access to management reporting information for decision support, metrics, and analysis (data warehouse).
- Improved Enterprise level Processes. Increase efficiencies in planning, sourcing, inventory, supply, delivery, and procurement of goods and services across multiple departments and divisions within the Church that leverage similar processes.
  - Ensure all related Supply Chain processes are appropriately documented prior to a project being approved for funding. This will allow the working group and others associated with the work to understand how the proposed solution fits into the global strategy and direction of the portfolio.
